


Exploring local biodiversity

Pupil worksheet



With an adult, you will be going on an outdoor journey to find out about your local biodiversity.

Step 1 – Plan your journey

- What risks might you come across outside?
- What can we do to stay safe around these risks?
- Draw a map of the route you will take

Step 2 - Materials

 Take paper and a pencil to help you record your journey

Step 3 – The journey

- Note down what you can see and hear
- Write down any questions you think of about biodiversity on your walk
- List one good thing for biodiversity you spot
- List one bad thing for biodiversity you spot

Step 4 – Back inside

- Compare with other people on the journey – did you spot the same things?
- How you could improve or support local biodiversity?

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
