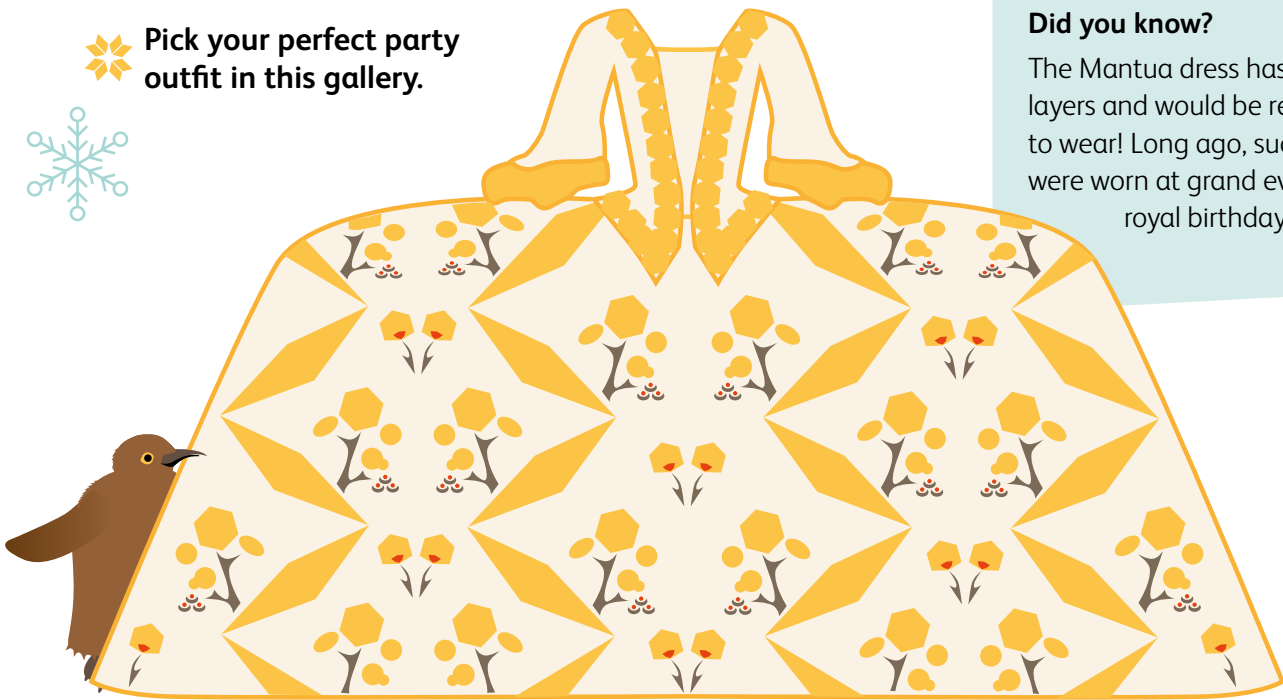
Hello, I'm a baby King Penguin! Follow me penguin-style. Turn out your toes, stretch out your flippers and off we go!

 This dress was worn by a noble lady. Try curtsying or bowing as if you were greeting her!

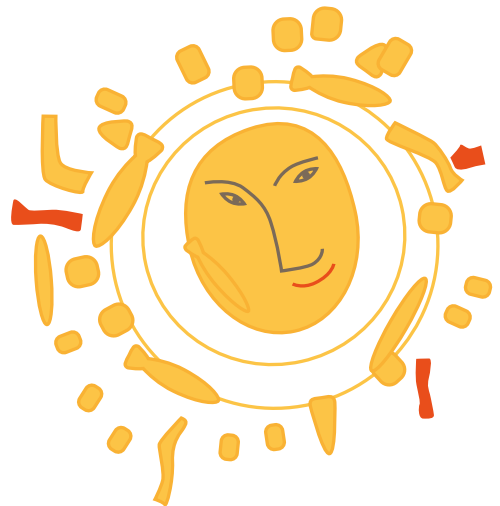
2 Living Lands gallery *Level 1*

 Demonstrate your favourite dance move!

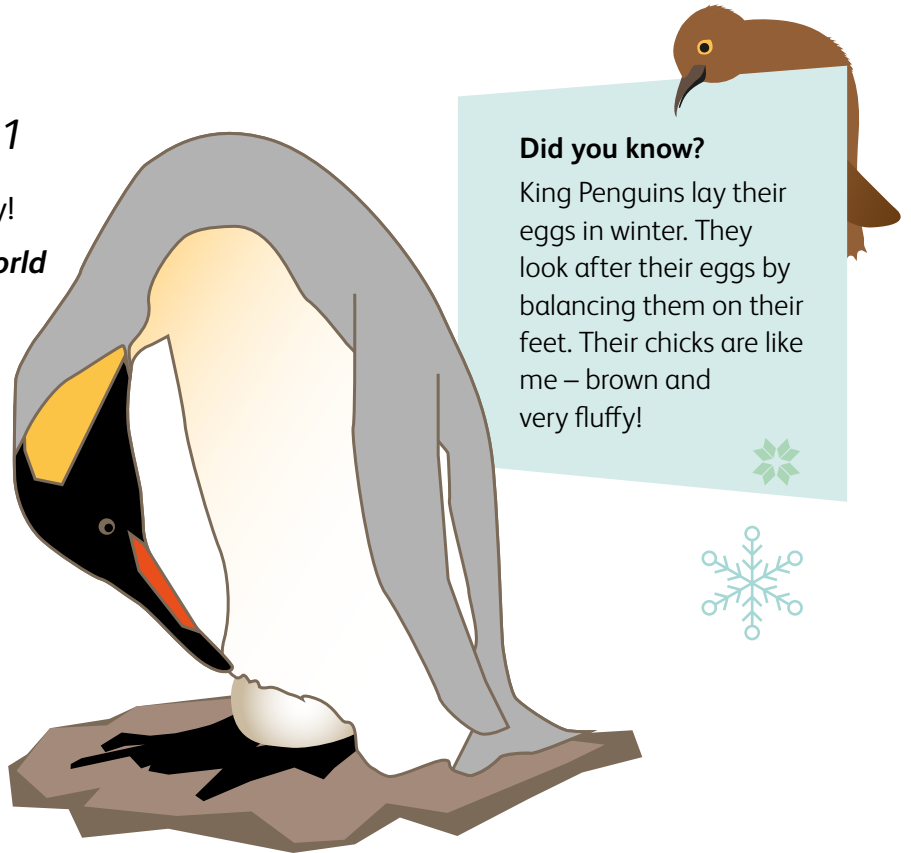


3 Animal World gallery Level 1

 Can you spot the rabbit at the bottom?

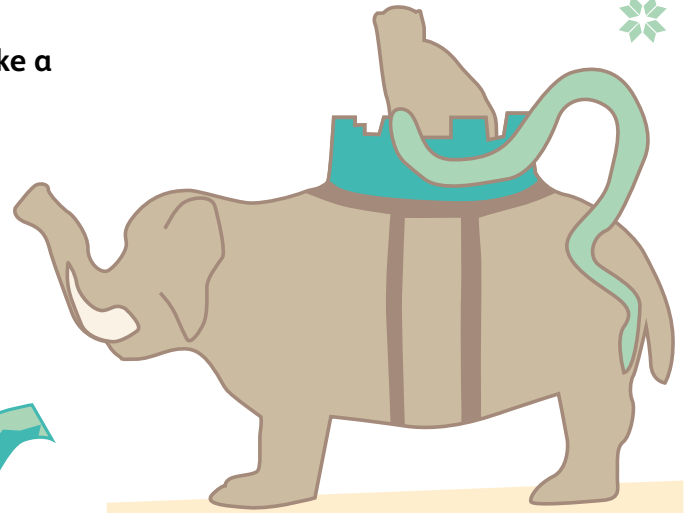
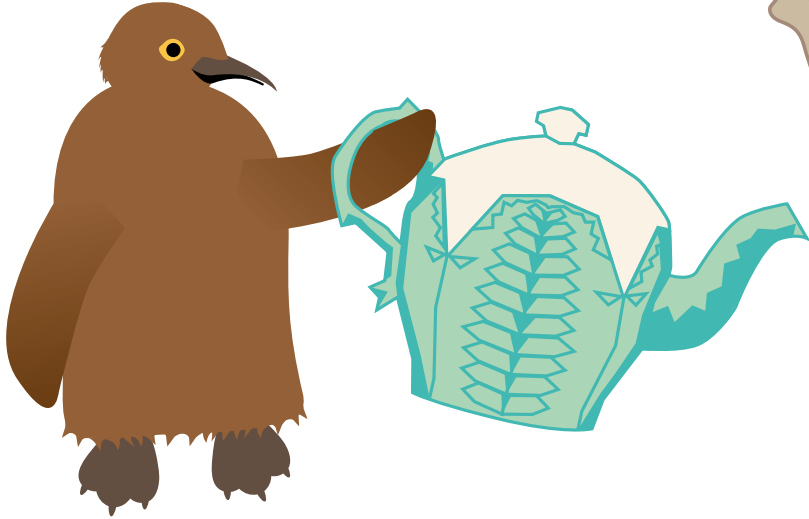
 How many birds are there all together?
