SALVE

Did you know?

Salve (sounds like Sal-Way) means “Hello” in Latin, the language used by the Romans.



SCUTUM

Did you know?

A scutum was a shield used by Roman soldiers.



CALEDONIA

Did you know?

Caledonia was the name the Romans gave to the land north of Hadrian’s Wall which includes what we call Scotland.



CALIGAE

Did you know?

Soldiers wore sandals called caligae. Romans in Scotland wrote home asking for socks to wear with them!
