Did you know, a female sheep is called a ewe?

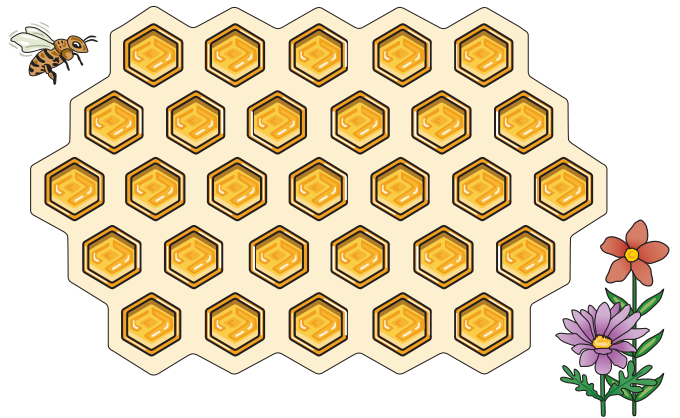
Spot one in our picture gallery!

Bees collect nectar and spread pollen, helping plants to grow.

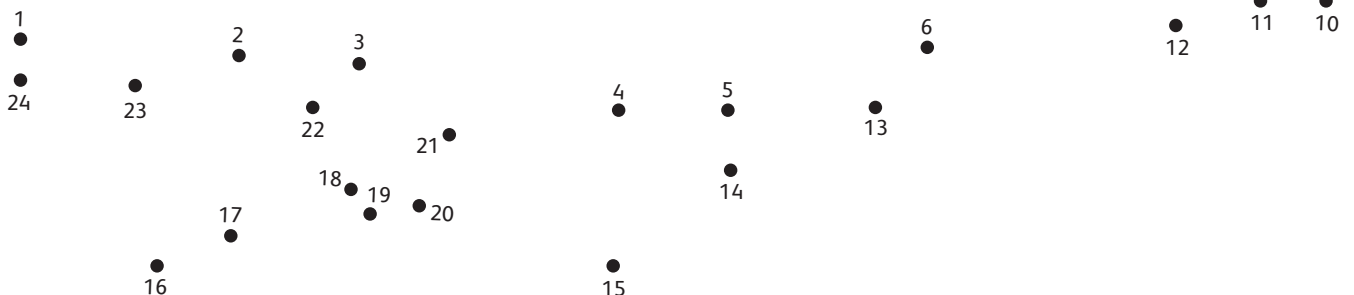
They tell their friends where the best nectar is by wagging their bottoms at each other. Can you buzz and waggle like a bee?

Help the bee get from the hive to the flowers?

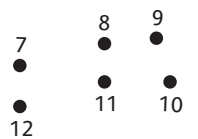


### Head to the Land gallery

What is he carrying in his jacket?



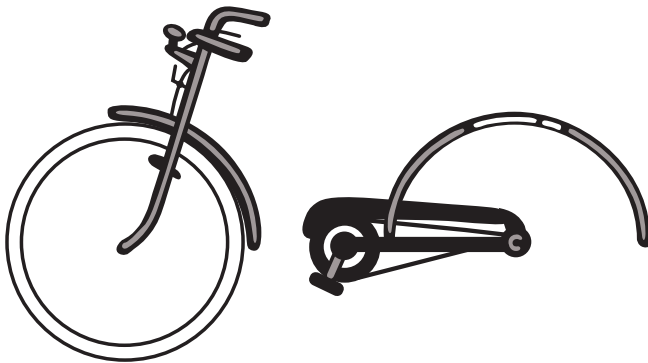
### Did you know?
