All trains in this timetable are ScotRail services operated by First, except where otherwise stated. We aim to make your train journey as easy as possible and are delighted to announce a number of enhancements to services across the network, including:

- the introduction of new services between Dunbar and Edinburgh.
- the Summer Sunday Kyle - Inverness service will depart earlier at 1034 to provide earlier connections to the south, and also the 1359 Inverness - Wick will include a stop at Culrain.
- the introduction of a new service at 0522 from Kilmarnock to Glasgow.
- the 1626 Edinburgh - Glasgow via Shotts will include a stop at Cambuslang.
- the new Class 380 trains will also be introduced on the Ayrshire and Inverclyde routes during the currency of this timetable.

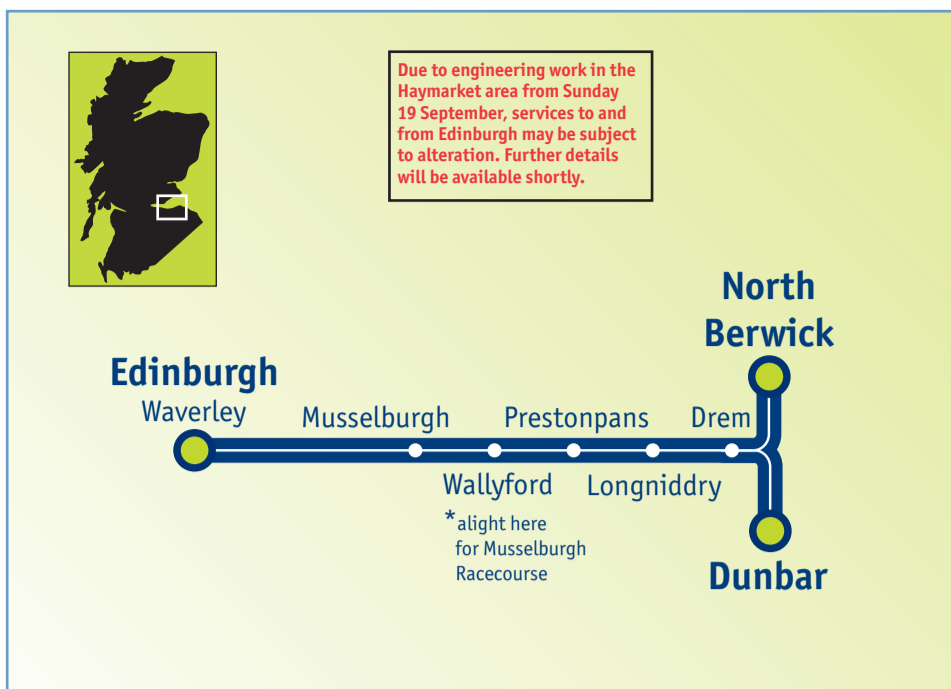

Travel Connections

If your final destination is not rail connected, ScotRail can still help.

PlusBus is an easy-to-use add-on to your train ticket which gives unlimited bus travel on most bus services around the whole urban area of your origin or destination. Railcard discounts are also available, and you can now also buy PlusBus online when you buy your train ticket.

Our range of **RailBus** tickets is aimed at connecting you to specific towns which are not on the rail network, without the hassle of buying separate rail and bus tickets. For example, if you buy a ticket from Glasgow to Peterhead this allows you to travel by train to Aberdeen then onwards by bus to Peterhead, without buying two separate tickets for each part of your journey – saving you time and hassle!

ScotRail also works closely with Scotland's ferry operators to provide combined **Rail & Sail** tickets.

ScotRail also welcomes **cyclists**, and we carry cycles free on all our services. Reservations are required on some longer distance routes, and these can be made at principal staffed stations or through ScotRail Telesales on 08457 55 00 33. We recommend that you make reservations as early as possible to avoid disappointment - they are generally available up to 12 weeks in advance of travel. On most other routes, reservations are not necessary, but space is limited on some trains.

Buying your ticket

To avoid queues, you can buy your ticket in advance at www.scotrail.co.uk, or by calling our Telesales team on 08457 55 00 33 between 0700 and 2200, seven days a week. All major credit/debit cards are accepted.

Seat reservations

Reservations are free when you buy a ticket for ScotRail services. It's always wise to try to book your seat. Reservations are available on many of our longer distance routes and are available up to 12 weeks in advance.

Help us to make your journey as safe as possible

- Ensure that you give yourself enough time to catch your train and never try to board or leave trains while doors are closing or the door closing alarm is sounding (doors close 30 seconds before departure).
- Please take the time to read the safety notices on-train as these contain information on emergency egress.
- Take care while walking in stations, and use the handrails where provided.
- Keep your luggage with you at all times and store securely while on-train.
- Mind the gap when boarding and alighting trains and be aware that some trains may be longer than the platform at stations on this route.

Please note, all ScotRail services and covered areas of stations are non-smoking.

Changing trains at stations

If you're changing trains at a station on our network, please allow at least five minutes for your connection, 10 minutes at Edinburgh Waverley and Glasgow Queen Street, 15 minutes at Glasgow Central and 30 minutes for the cross-city transfer between Glasgow Queen Street and Glasgow Central. A special cross-city bus service between Glasgow Queen Street and Glasgow Central is available free to valid ticket holders. Customers without a valid rail ticket are also welcome to use this service but must pay the relevant fare.

Please note that trains may divide en route - check with staff that you are in the correct portion of the train.
