



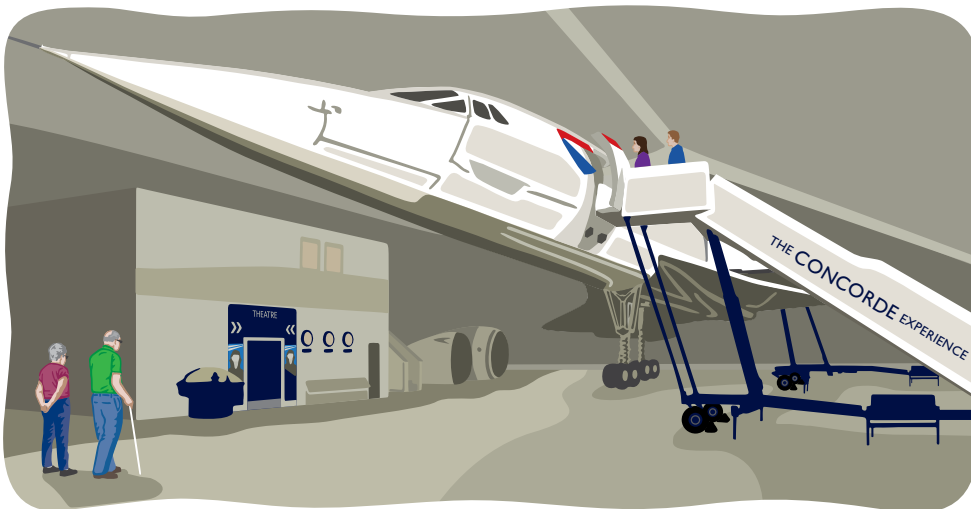
Must see:

Why not give the assault course a go or a picnic in the fresh air!



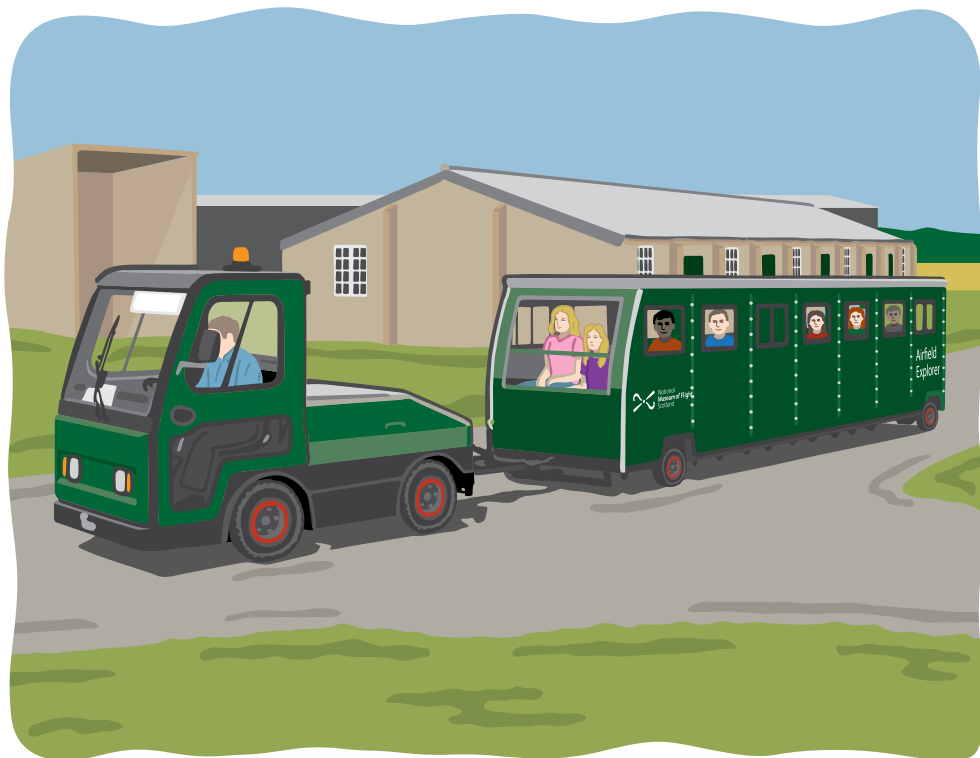
Top tip:
