General information



Information desks, Levels 0, 1, 3

Information desks are located in the Entrance Hall and Tower Entrance.

Tickets for events and exhibitions can be purchased at the Entrance Hall information desk and, while an exhibition is running, at the Exhibition Ticket Desk located on Level 3.

Cloakroom, Level 0

Coats and bags may be left in the Cloakroom in the Entrance Hall. Charges and weight restrictions apply.

Access

There are lifts to all floors, adapted toilets, a Changing Places toilet and wheelchairs for loan from the information desks.

Induction loops are in place at the information desks and in the Auditorium. Our 'Hearing Helper' Tour Guide system is available for tours – please ask at the Entrance Hall information desk.

Special tours, handling sessions for visually impaired visitors or a BSL interpreter can be arranged in advance. Call **0131 247 4040**, visit nms.ac.uk/tours or email tours@nms.ac.uk.

Registered and identifiable assistance dogs are welcome.

Imagine, World Cultures, Level 1

Designed especially for families with young children, this gallery offers a chance to make music, tell stories and create art inspired by objects from around the world.

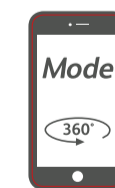

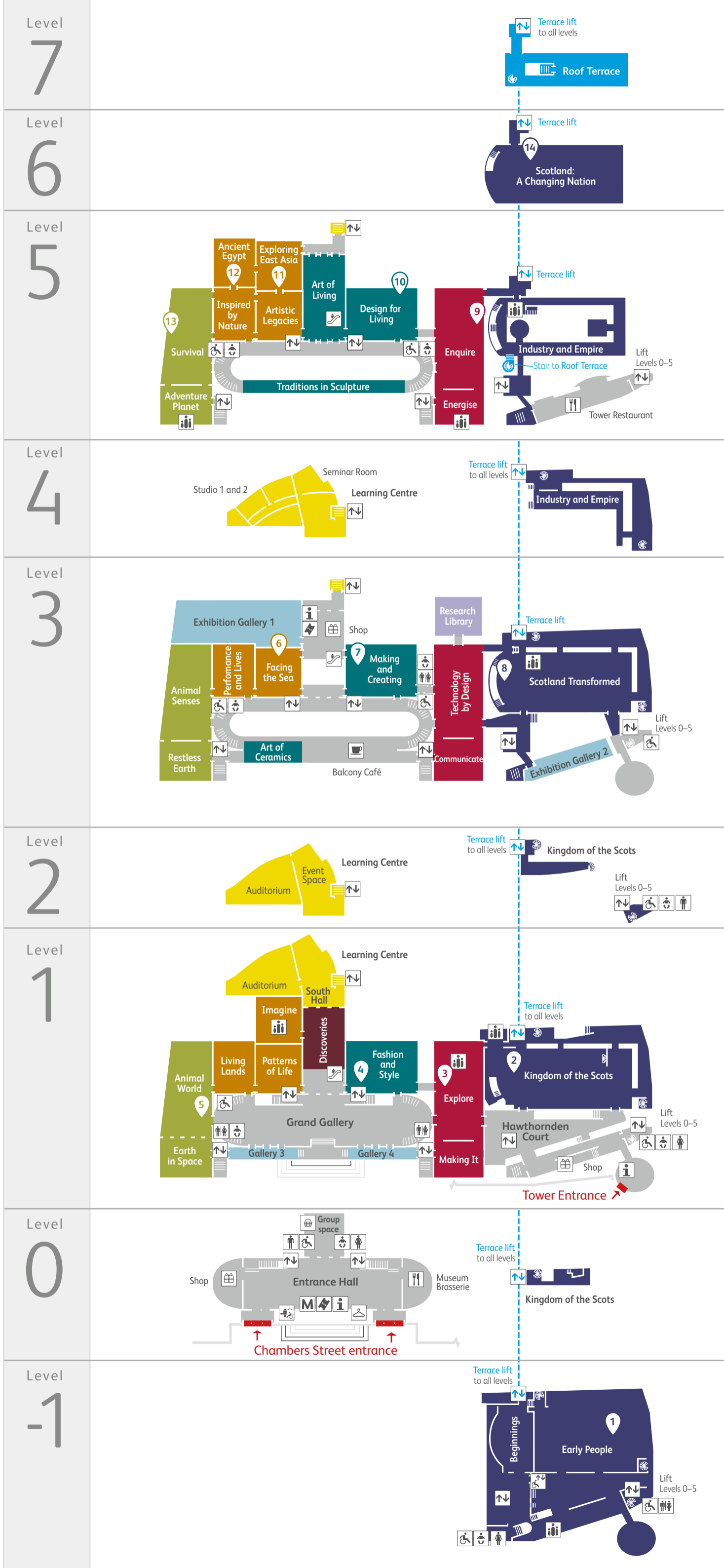
