There is one item from the Marshall Islands. Although this collection is small in number, there are very few artefacts from the Marshall Islands in Scotland.

This item is a composite fish hook (ABDUA: 4056) formed from part of a pearl shell with a bone barb. The hook has a twisted plant fibre line attached. It was previously attributed to New Zealand.
